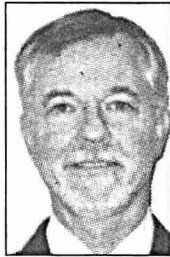

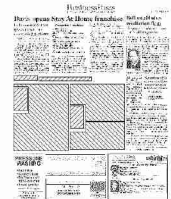
Infiniti in Circle of Excellence
